Hi All,

I had a quick chat with [REDACTED] from Huon Aquaculture, re the Electona ensiler.

All morts from Huon's Storm Bay leases from this summer are being processed at the Electrona ensiler, they have been doing 5-6 days with a single tanker load per day going out over February at Electrona.

They calculate about 20 – 22m3/ tanker load – I'm not totally sure how morts received relate to product going out but less morts weight goes in than ensiled product comes out.

I'd say a rough guesstimate of 400 – 500 tonnes of morts may have gone to the Electrona ensiler for February.

More exact figures will be provided around 17 March (when their reporting is due under the finfish EL).

The finished ensiled product from Electrona is being applied by Spectran at the St Peter's Pass property.
