**Notification to Chief
Inspector of Mines**



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The *Mines Work Health and Safety (Supplementary Requirements) Act 2012 (section 14)* requires a Mine Operator to appoint a Site Senior Officer before any mining operations are carried out at the mine. The Mine Operator must then advise the Chief Inspector of Mines in writing of that person's name, relevant experience and qualifications. The Mine Operator must also advise the Chief Inspector of Mines of any subsequent change in the appointment. The Act can be downloaded free from www.thelaw.tas.gov.au
