Landfill Facilities (e.g. Copping, Dulverton)	The EPA does not store data requested in this RTI 074.	There are multiple premises that have EPA approval to receive controlled waste.  Permits are available on theLIST
Beneficial Reuse (Land spreading)	The EPA does not store data requested in this RTI 074.	Councils are responsible for issuing of EPN's for this activity and are required under EMPCA to provide copies of EPN's issued to the EPA.  There are multiple premises that have the necessary approval (i.e. EPN) to undertake land spreading of fish waste.
Transport Companies	The EPA does not store data requested in this RTI 074 for transportation companies.  Waste transporter conditions are available on the EPA website in Appendix I of the <a href="#">Controlled Waste Transport - Spill Management Plan Guide</a>	Must hold appropriate EPA approvals to transport controlled waste.  The EPA maintain a publicly available list of Registered <a href="#">Controlled Waste Transporters</a> . Transporters permitted to carry finfish mortalities have an authorised controlled waste code of K100 and/or DEADF.
