

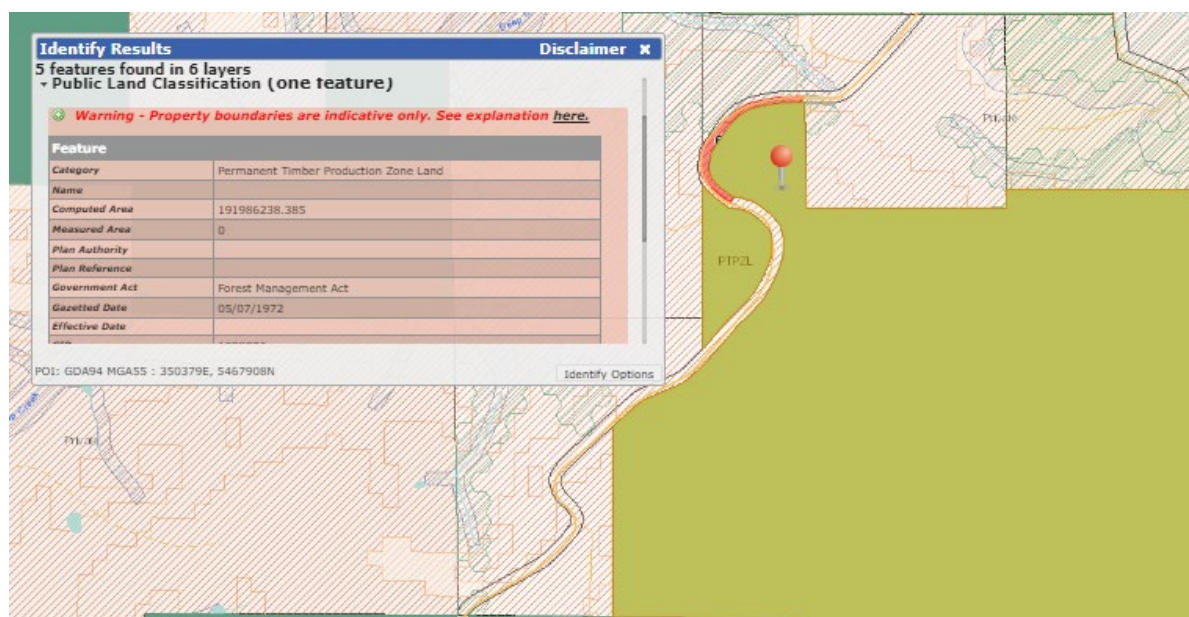

Hi Barry,

Apologies for the mistake. The site is not a Private Timber Reserve.

However, it is still exempted from the application of *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993* (LUPAA) and Tasmanian Planning Scheme – Circular Head as following reason:

1. Land zoning and tenure: Permanent Timber Production Zone (PTPZ) land (refer to picture below);
2. **Quarry** in the site is classified as forest operations under Section 11 of LUPAA;
3. PTPZ land or State forest is defined as a Crown land under Section 3 of *Forest Management Act 2013*;
4. Crown land is public land in the State as a definition under Section 4 of *Public Land (Administration and Forests) Act 1991*;
5. LUPAA application does not apply to public land under Section 4 of LUPAA.
