RE: PROPOSED CHANGES TO CRUSHING VOLUME

As previously discussed with Anthony Cook, Forestry Tasmania (trading as Sustainable Timber Tas) wishes to apply to increase the volume of crushed product from 2000m³ up to 8000m³

Our proposed intention will allow us to cost effectively engage a third party contractor to utilize a mobile crushing unit onsite and crush the desired amount of material that we can then use as required for the next 12 month period. Some of our previous blasts have resulted in insufficient fragmentation for use on our roads and needs to be processed via crushing methods.

The specific quarry is known as 'Peppermint Hill' and is located in the Lileah region (E350400, N5468000), which is part of the Permanent Timber Production Zone land within the municipality of Circular Head.

This quarry is covered by our Forest Practices Plan (FPP# - DRT0222) as required under the Forest Practices Act (1985) and has been identified in conjunction with our Three Year Wood Production Plan which forms an important part of meeting our legislated and contractual wood supply commitments. Therefore, the proposed products identified above shall only be utilised to construct and/or maintain forestry roads on forestry land.

In support of this application, I enclose,

- 1) A copy of the approved Forest Practices Plan, DRT0222 for 'Peppermint Hill' including site plan, profiles and location map (this FPP has been developed in accordance with the Forest Practices Code and our own internal procedures that seek to maintain or enhance environmental and cultural values relating to flora, fauna, geomorphology, soil and water, cultural heritage and visual landscape),
- 2) A copy of variation 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.
- 3) A copy of the current Environment Protection Notice
- 4) The proposed EPN variation to increase crushing quantity
